They had a dedicated person to set up the equipment, and he took pains to make sure everything worked (even turning off all the lights before the start to check the colours etc). The venue opened 45 mins before the start, so I had plenty of time to set up. There was a prompt start, with minimal other business. Everyone was very helpful and friendly. Payment of fees was presented in a handwritten note of thanks which was a gift card of Tenby - a nice touch. They even had a press officer who approached me after and asked (unprompted) for details for local press publication.
