Copyright on ICE

We've received this from Alun Williams at Cynon Isaf. It is regarding the Institute of Chartered Engineers photo competition currently being widely publicised. (See below for details of the competition).

I've been passed an email by one of our members from the Institute of Chartered Engineers regarding an up-coming photo competition. I believe this has been circulated to most photo clubs. A quick look at the regulations reveals that the images entered may be used by ICE for marketing etc. worldwide without payment of a fee. Obviously anyone can enter if they choose but they should be aware that their photographs could be used at will without them being compensated.

I have campaigned strongly for years as a professional and amateur against blatant attempts to secure a wide resource of imaging material at little cost. I feel that these tactics along with the emasculation of copyright law will in time devalue the merit and worth of good photography.

This is Civil Engineering Photography Competition

We have received this from the Institution of Civil Engineers (ICE) Wales:-

Civil engineering is all around us. From the Millennium Stadium to the Menai Bridge, it has helped to shape our world. Philip Jones Griffiths Exhibition

A new exhibition celebrating the life and work of the celebrated Welsh photojournalist, **Philip Jones Griffiths**, is on at the National Library of Wales, Aberystwyth. It runs until **12th December**. More details <u>here</u>.

Griffiths, who died in 2008, is best-known for his photographs of civilian casualties and suffering during the war in Vietnam. He published a book in 1971, 'Vietnam Inc.', which helped turn public opinion against the war. Philip Jones Griffiths – A Welsh Focus on War and Peace features photography and slides from the book as well as earlier and later work. For the first time, many of Griffiths' cameras, papers and artefacts will be displayed alongside his photos.

PAGB Awards for Photographic Merit (APMs)

For the first time in several years, the WPF is hosting the APMs and many WPF members have applied. **On 28/9 November 2015**, Jan Cawley will become the first WPF judge to adjudicate at the APMs.

It is generally perceived that applicants, who have sought advice on the contents of their entry, have been more successful.
